As an accomplished academic and researcher, I am currently serving as a Professor in the Department of Finance and Banking at Islamic University, Kushtia, Bangladesh. My career has been marked by a robust blend of teaching excellence, cutting-edge research, and significant contributions to the field of finance. My research interests are diverse, encompassing capital structure, ethical finance, microfinance, women empowerment, volatility connectedness, and financial crisis. I have led and participated in numerous high-impact research projects, securing funding from prestigious organizations such as Fulbright University of Vietnam, UGC, and different Universities. My research has resulted in 27 publications in top-tier finance and economics journals, including International Journal of Emerging Markets, Journal of Risk and Financial Management, Journal of Developing Areas, International Journal of Economics and Finance, etc. I am also actively engaged in research collaboration with domestically and internationally renowned professors of Finance and Economics and have presented my findings at several global conferences. Since 2015, I have actively engaged in research and motivated my students to do so. I along with my colleague Dr. Md. Bokhtiar Hasan, who is a very prominent researcher worldwide, form a research lab at our Department. The notable achievement of our lab is that under our guidance, three students recently received Fulbright PhD scholarships to top U.S. universities this year (2024) and a few others obtained a partial scholarship in other European and Australian universities, with several other candidates in the pipeline. I am currently overseeing several research papers under revision or review in leading journals, reflecting my ongoing commitment to advancing knowledge in finance. My role as a reviewer for prominent journals further underscores my expertise and contribution to the field.
